1.

Tires - Your safety is our top priority

Winter tires are essential for safe travel in winter.

Please note:

→ All-weather tires are only a compromise & do not offer the same safety in winter conditions as genuine winter tires. Especially on:

- Hills
- Alpine roads
- Snow & ice

Winter tires ensure significantly greater driving stability—& a relaxed arrival.

2.

Check the weather conditions in good time

Please check the current weather conditions before departure.

The following are particularly important:

- Weather conditions along the entire route
- Snow line
- Temperatures at your destination

We recommend planning your journey during daylight hours if possible.

Late arrivals in the evening can be difficult in winter due to icy or snow-covered roads.

3.

Snow chains – be prepared

For motorhomes (& cars with trailers), carrying snow chains is highly recommended.

Please ensure:

- that the snow chains fit your vehicle
- that they have ideally been fitted once before

This will help you avoid unnecessary stress in winter conditions.

4.

Gas supply – cozy warmth in winter

In winter, it is particularly important to have a sufficient supply of gas, as this is essential for heating your vehicle. Please note:

- Ensure you have a sufficient supply of gas.
- It is better to plan for an extra reserve bottle.
- Consumption increases at low temperatures.

Relaxed arrival thanks to good timing

The best way to travel in winter is to:

- Leave a little earlier
- Allow plenty of time
- Drive calmly

This will ensure you start your stay safely & stress-free.

Realistically assess local weather conditions

Winter road conditions may also occur locally.

We will, of course, take care of this:

- Clearing paths
- Gritting & securing

Please understand that this is only possible within the scope of the current weather conditions.

If snowfall or sub-zero temperatures are forecast, we recommend:

- Limiting travel to what is necessary
- Ensuring you have good, non-slip footwear on site

7.

On-site facilities

Each pitch at the campsite has electricity & water. However, due to the low temperatures, the water supply to the pitches is turned off during the winter months.

- Water is supplied via the sanitary buildings.

There is a hose reel in the room below the infinity pool where you can fill up with fresh water at any time. Otherwise, we recommend bringing watering cans or canisters with you.
